

Parochial School Application Guide

Application Guide for the Academy of the Holy Angels (AHA)

1. Please go to <https://www.holyangels.org/9th-grade-application> to begin the application process. Once you review all important dates and information on the webpage, scroll all the way down.
2. Click on the green **Log In to Start** button next to “9th Grade Application.” Scroll down to the very bottom of the new web page. Click **register now** to create your **required application username and password**. (Remember to save this account information!)
3. Once you have your new account, you must fill out all required forms, including the **Inquiry** and **9th Grade Application**. Please make sure all information included is correct. Pay the \$25 non-refundable application fee.
4. After you fill out the **9th Grade Application**, AHA will automatically register you for the SSAT. AHA has its own special SSAT test date for 8th grade applicants on **November 4, 2017**. When you take the SSAT through AHA, you receive a discount on the exam.

***If you plan to take the SSAT in October or December, you can report your scores to AHA with the school code **1060** on the official SSAT Application Portal. AHA highly suggests you take the exam on November 4 to ensure your scores get sent to their admissions department on time.

Important Tip: HSPT Score Report for Regis High School Cannot Be Sent to Other Schools

1. **All public school students interested in applying to Regis High School must contact the Regis Admissions Office directly** and provide their **7th grade report cards** and **standardized testing information**.
2. Once Regis High School receives this information, you will be given a **student application access code** to set up your admissions account.
3. Set up your account and complete **all application forms**. You must submit by **October 23rd**. Once you submit the application, you will automatically be registered for Regis’s HSPT exam on **November 4, 2017**. All applicants must attend this exam date at Regis. You may not make up the HSPT for Regis on any other test date.
4. **Regis High School will not release HSPT scores to other schools except for Saint Peter’s Prep**. If you are applying to other schools that require the HSPT, you will have to take it again to submit your score.
5. Students who are applying to other schools requiring the HSPT should register for the **November 10, 2017** official HSPT exam date at <https://www.njcoopexam.org/>. This will allow you to submit an official HSPT score to other schools.
6. To register for the 11/10 exam, click on **Online Application Registration** and fill out all required information.
